



Dear Corporate Race League Captains,  
Welcome to the start of the 2011-2012 ski season! Here at Gunstock, we are preparing for a great winter. There have been some changes this season, so please read through the following information carefully, and feel free to contact us at (603) 737-4368. Also check <http://www.gunstock.com/mountain/racing/>  
For 2011-2012, we have Corporate Race leagues on Monday afternoons, and Wednesday evening and Thursday evening. Racers with valid Monday bibs may use the lifts all day on Monday. Racers with valid Wednesday and Thursday bibs may use the lifts from 3pm to closing on those nights. We are scheduled to start races the week of January 9<sup>th</sup>.

Team fees for this season:

- \$600 to \$1200 for Monday teams, depending on the number of racers on the team
- \$600 for Wednesday teams consisting of 5 members
- \$1200 for Thursday teams with up to 10 members (same price for fewer members)

**New this year, we encourage Team Captains to collect fees and make a single payment to Gunstock Mountain Resort. This policy will be required next season.**

The Corporate Race series lasts 8 weeks, with bonus times on Registration night and at the end-of-series ski-off. Après ski socials occur after each race night, including the ski-off.

If you have a team to register, please consider the following deadlines:

- December 1<sup>st</sup>; returning teams need to return rosters and waivers, and pay all fees in order to guarantee a spot. After December 1<sup>st</sup>, availability is 1<sup>st</sup> come, 1<sup>st</sup> served.
- December 16<sup>th</sup>: all teams need to return rosters and waivers, and pay all fees.
- **December 21<sup>st</sup>: Any unpaid registrations will be charged a late fee of \$20 per racer.**

On December 16<sup>th</sup>, Gunstock will hold a Registration Night for Corporate racers. Final registrations and payments must be made that night also. Registration will begin at 4pm, and there will be a Captains' meeting at 8:15. Racers who have paid and registered may ski free from 4-close on Registration Night.

A couple of details:

- Racers must have a bib to ride the lift. Bibs must be worn on the outer layer, across the chest. If a racer has forgotten or lost a bib, there is a \$10 charge for a temporary bib, or \$25 for a replacement bib. Any transfer or misuse of bibs is considered theft of services.
- Teams must have their fees paid in full before their 1<sup>st</sup> race. Bibs will only be issued to racers who have paid in full, and who have current waivers on file.
- Bibs are only valid on race days. If a race is cancelled, bibs are not valid for the lifts.
- Captains are responsible for contacting racers about changes to the race schedule. The Race Department will contact Captains regarding any changes. Captains can contact Gunstock at (603) 737-4368. Weather does not generally affect racing; be prepared to race in snow, ice or rain!
- Racers should inspect the course before racing. Once the race starts, it is closed to inspection. Inspections must be done in a safe manner.
- The course is closed during set-up and preparation. We suggest warming up on other trails, with respect to non-racing skiers.
- Error corrections should be reported as soon as possible to Race Department Staff.
- Protests are due the day *before* the next race day. Protests must be in written form; please get a protest form from the Race Department or online. Protests are void after 1 week. Race officials have final decision on all protests.
- Helmets are encouraged, but not required.
