



Monday Race Specifics:

For Monday League teams, size may vary from 5 to as many as 10 members. All team members are eligible to ski and score for their team. Teams will have until the day before Race #3 to add or replace members. After Race #3, the roster is frozen for the rest of the season. Teams that initially have fewer than 10 members may add members for \$120 each up until Race #3. Monday racers are automatically entered into NASTAR® using registration data. Monday racers earn regional and national standings, and may qualify for post-season NASTAR® Nationals.

The Monday League is sponsored by adult beverage companies; as a result, all racers must be **21** years or older and sign the liability waiver *before* racing. Any team that runs an ineligible racer will be disqualified from that particular race, and the bib number may be disqualified for the season. The ineligible individual is disqualified for the season, without a refund.

Team captains are responsible for allocating the correctly numbered bibs to racers. Captains should check with Race Department staff if there are any questions. A team that runs a racer on the wrong bib will be disqualified for that race, and the bib number may be “retired” for the season.

Finishers are divided into seed groups. There will be a constant number of seed groups for each race series. The number of seed groups will be evaluated depending on the final number of racers in the men’s and women’s groups. When the number of racers is not evenly divisible by the number of seed groups, the remaining race scores are placed in the last seed.

Gunstock’s Grand Prix scoring keeps the series competitive for all participants. Points are awarded for same-placed finishers in each seed group. For ties across seed groups, the tied racers move into a higher group. At least 1 point is earned for each finisher. Teams are scored by the top 5 point earners. For the season’s scores, the worst week’s score is dropped. In the event of a season tie, the last week’s score is used. Individual scores are also tabulated for the season.

Monday’s races are single course Giant Slalom, with 13-18 gates on Ramrod. Changes in format must be approved by a majority of team captains. Changes will be published in advance at <http://www.gunstock.com/mountain/racing/>. Running orders are on a rotating basis by team, with no separate 1st and 2nd run lines. Non-scoring fun runs may be available in the last ½ hour of racing, at the discretion of the Race Department staff.
