

SoulFest 2010 Campground Amenities and Activities

Thank you for camping at Gunstock during SoulFest. The following information is to help acquaint you with our facilities and amenities.

Safety and Security

Gunstock's First Aid Base will be staffed round the clock during the festival. First Aid is located in the Guest Services' Lodge, next to the Welcome Center. However, if there is a medical, fire or any other life threatening emergency at your campsite, call 911 immediately.

Gunstock will have night security on patrol in the campground during the festival. Our security staff can be reached after 6PM at 603-455-1275.

Gunstock is an outdoor recreational area and adjoins the Belknap Mountain State Park. Remember that we share the woods with wildlife. Please follow these suggestions from the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department if you don't want bears or other animals as camping partners:

- Maintain a clean campsite.
- Put food scraps and fat drippings in closed containers, not in the campfire.
- Do not cook or eat in your tent.
- Keep food and cooking gear separate from your sleeping area.
- Keep food in a closed-up vehicle or hang food at least 10 feet off the ground and five feet out on a limb that will not support a bear.
- Never feed bears intentionally.

If you spot a bear or other wildlife during your stay at Gunstock, please enjoy watching them from a distance. Respect them and their presence in the wild.

Help Protect our Trees – Please leave your firewood at home

Trees are being destroyed through the transportation of invasive insects and diseases in firewood. Gunstock is asking our guests not to move firewood into our campground unless you are certain it has been harvested locally or has been kiln dried. Camping Supplies

Mountainside Outfitters General Store - a fully equipped camp store is located at the end of the deck above the Welcome Center. Store hours are: 7AM to 10PM. Hot coffee is available every morning. Stock up or replenish:

Campground Amenities

Bathrooms - Showers - Laundry

- Bathrooms are located on Cedar and Fir Lanes; and in the Corner and Brookside bath houses.
- Bath house and laundry facilities are located across from the Poplar field. Hot showers are available in the bathhouses. Due to the number of campers at the festival, please plan to limit your shower time to 3 minutes and consider using the bathhouse at off-peak hours.
- Laundry detergent is available at the Mountainside Outfitters. A change machine is located on the lower level of the Main Lodge.
- Brookside Bathhouse is handicapped accessible. Coin operated lockers are available.
- Port-o-Sans are also located throughout the campground and near the Campside and Mountainside campsites.
- The bathrooms in the Main Lodge will be open from 7AM to midnight during the festival.

Water

Water spigots are located throughout the campground and on the outside of the bath house buildings. The spigots are indicated on the campground map with an asterisk(*). Garden hoses cannot be attached to public water spigots. Water provided on Premium sites is for one site only. Please do not wash dishes in the bathroom sinks.

Trash

Please put all trash in dumpsters. Wood, ashes and large items are not to go in the dumpsters. Recycling will be available inside the SoulFest gates.

Dump Station

There are two dump stations at the campground. One is located across from the pavilion near the tree line; the other is located at the intersection of Middle Hill Road and the main camp road.

Phones – ATM - WiFi

- A pay phone is located outside the Welcome Center.
- An ATM machine is located on the ground level of the Main Lodge.
- WiFi is available in and near the Main Lodge.

Swimming

Gunstock has an in-ground swimming pool, located near the bath houses in the campground. During SoulFest, the pool will be staffed by Gunstock's Adaptive Sports Center volunteers. Hours of operation will be 10AM to 8PM. A \$2 fee will allow access for a 1 hour period. All proceeds will benefit the Gunstock Adaptive Sports Center, providing access to skiing and riding for people with physical, emotional and cognitive challenges.

Gunstock has a fishing pond located near the main lodge. Please note:

- There are no lifeguards on duty at the pond, therefore swimming is at your own risk.
- Jumping from the dam or trees is prohibited.

Fishing

The pond is stocked by New Hampshire Fish and Game. Licenses are required for persons 16 years and older. Licenses are not available for sale on Gunstock property. Please go to the Fish and Game web site www.wildlife.state.nh.us for a list of sales agents or to purchase a license on-line.

Hiking

Wetlands Boardwalk

Gunstock, in partnership with the Belknap County Conservation District is home to a quarter mile handicapped accessible wetlands boardwalk, complete with benches for resting. It is located near the Boardwalk (BW) section of the campground. Biking is not allowed on the boardwalk.

Hiking Trails

There are several marked nature trails to explore while you are here. Maps are available in the Mountainside Outfitters Store. For your hiking safety, please stay on marked trails, wear sturdy footwear and let somebody know your hiking plans. Help us protect our environment by leaving live things live and packing out what you bring in.

Cobble Mountain Stables – Horse back trail rides

The stables are located near the Pistol Parking Lot (on the far side of the Main parking lot). Operating Hours are 9AM to 5PM daily. Riders must be 8 years old and up. Trail rides approximately 1 hour in length. The cost is \$50 per person.

Panorama Chairlift Rides

The Panorama Chairlift, which provides access to the Gunstock Summit and the Mountain Top Stage, will be operating weather permitting from mid-morning until late-afternoon. Hours will be posted daily. The cost for a one-day pass is \$10. For only \$25 you can ride the lift for all 4 days of the festival. Passes will be sold at the base of the lift for cash sales only. Credit card purchases can be made at the Mountainside Outfitters Store.

Lift passes that have been purchased in advance are being mailed the week of July 19th.
